BOTTOM LINE: God has a plan for me.

MEMORY VERSE: “For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord.” - Jeremiah 29:11

BIBLE STORY: God’s plan has good things for me to do.

Joseph Saves the Grain • *Genesis 41*

Pharaoh puts Joseph in charge of saving grain after Joseph helps him understand his dreams.

ACTIVITY 1 – INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY

MAKE IT FUN

INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY | MEMORY VERSE HOP

What You Need: 10 items to lay out

What You Do:

During the Activity: Lay out 10 items on the floor (paper plates, small toys etc.)

Have the children hop from spot to spot as they say the memory verse.

Repeat several times.

What You Say:

During the Activity: “Let’s get hopping! We’ll say our memory verse while we hop from spot to spot Let’s get started!” (*Do activity.*)

Great job! Our memory verse tells us that God has a plan for us! **Who has a plan for you? [Bottom Line] God has a plan for me!”**

APPLICATION ACTIVITY | JOSEPH AND THE GRAIN

What You Need: “Grain” Activity Page, yellow markers/crayons (or paint, tissue paper, yellow pompoms etc.)

What You Do:

During the Activity: Give each child one activity page and something to make the grain yellow (yellow markers/crayons or paint, tissue paper, yellow pompoms etc.) Review the story. Encourage children to fill in the grain.

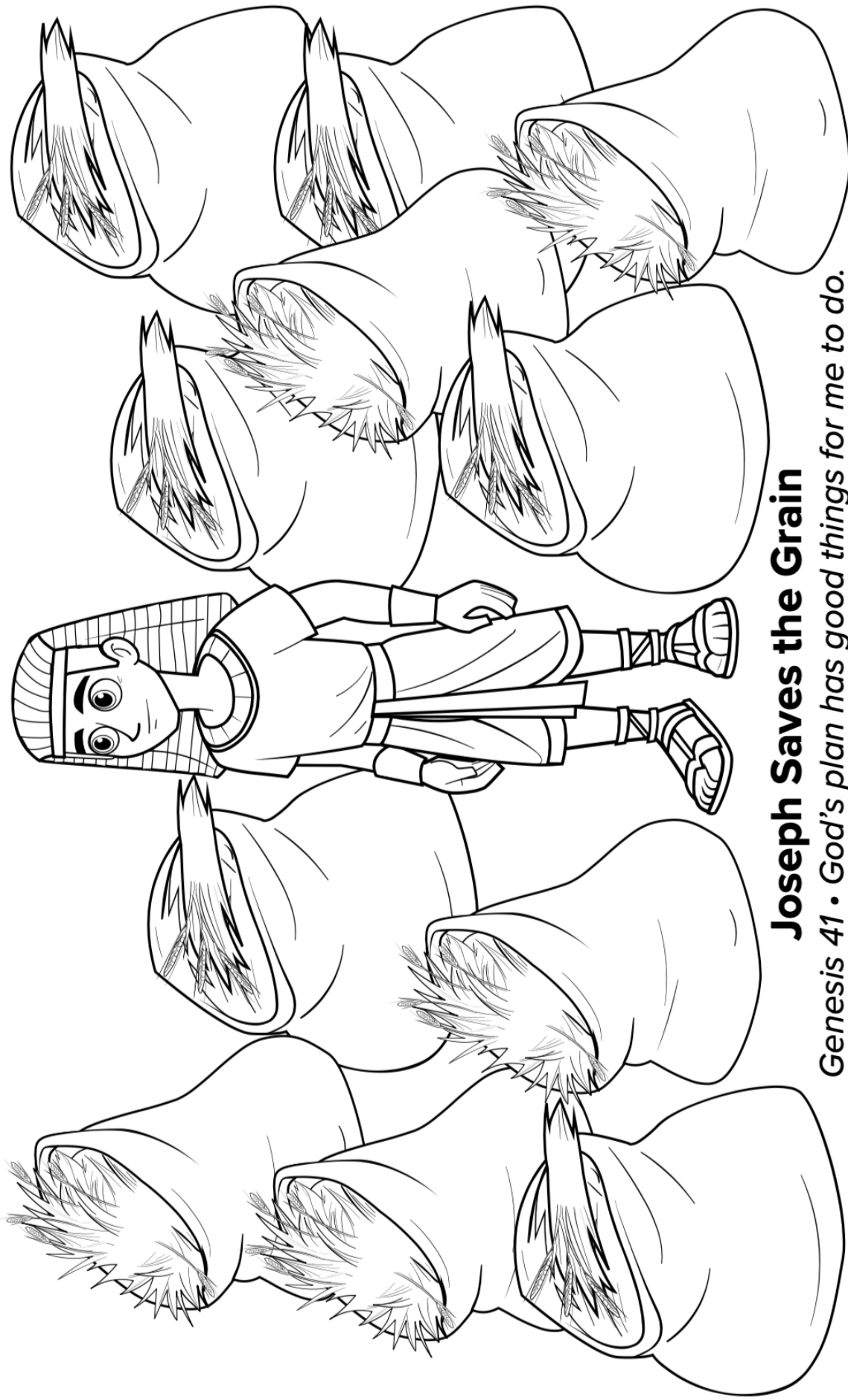
What You Say:

Before the Activity: “Today, we learned that while Joseph was in jail, Pharaoh had a really weird dream. It was about seven cows and stalks of grain! Pharaoh didn’t understand what the dream meant, but Joseph did! Joseph told Pharaoh that the dreams were from God. They meant that Pharaoh needed to save lots and lots of grain, because his people were going to be hungry and need it later! Pharaoh was SO happy to know what his dreams meant, that he gave Joseph a very special job. He put Joseph in CHARGE of all of Egypt. Years later, the dreams came true. People were hungry and didn’t have food, so they traveled from all over to get grain from Joseph.

During the Activity: “Look, there’s Joseph next to the grain he saved! *(Pause.)* Let’s make our grain yellow *(Pause.)* Good job, friends. You can also color your picture!

After the Activity: “In all the things that Joseph went through, he loved God. God had a plan for Joseph, and no matter how hard things were, Joseph knew that God loved him, God was always with him, and God had a plan for him. I love how Joseph followed God’s plan. There will be times that are hard for us, but we can know that God loves us, God is with us, and God has a plan for us. God’s plan is the best plan. I love how Joseph followed God’s plan. I want to follow God’s plan, and you can, too.

Who has a plan for you? [Bottom Line] God has a plan for me.”
