BASIC TRUTH: God loves me.

KEY QUESTION: Who's got it?

BOTTOM LINE: God's got it.

MEMORY VERSE: "God is with you wherever you go." - Joshua 1:9

BIBLE STORY: God hears me and gives me what I need.

Hagar • *Genesis 21:14-20*

God hears Hagar's son crying in the desert and gives them the water they need.

ACTIVITY 1 – INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY

MAKE IT FUN

INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY | UMBRELLA

What You Need: A sheet

What You Do:

Ask the children to stand around the parachute with you and each pick up a section of the parachute. Ask the children to raise the parachute high by raising their arms in the air. When the parachute is high, challenge the children to let go of the parachute and go under it while it is in the air. Allow the parachute to fall on top of the children. Repeat several times.

What You Say:

"Let's pretend that it's raining and we need an umbrella! Let's play with the sheet! Lift your arms high in the air. When the parachute is super high, let go and go under it so it can be our umbrella. Let's give it a try!" (*Do activity.*) That was awesome! God is always with us just like He was with Hagar in our Bible story. **[Bottom Line] God's got it. Who's got it? [Bottom Line] God's got it!"**

ACTIVITY 3 – APPLICATION ACTIVITY

MAKE IT STICK

APPLICATION ACTIVITY | IN THE RAIN

What You Need: “Umbrella Verse” Activity Page, blue washable inkpad/blue paint/blue markers or crayons

What You Do:

During the Activity: Encourage children to make raindrops on their paper with their fingerprints / or paint / or crayons / or markers.

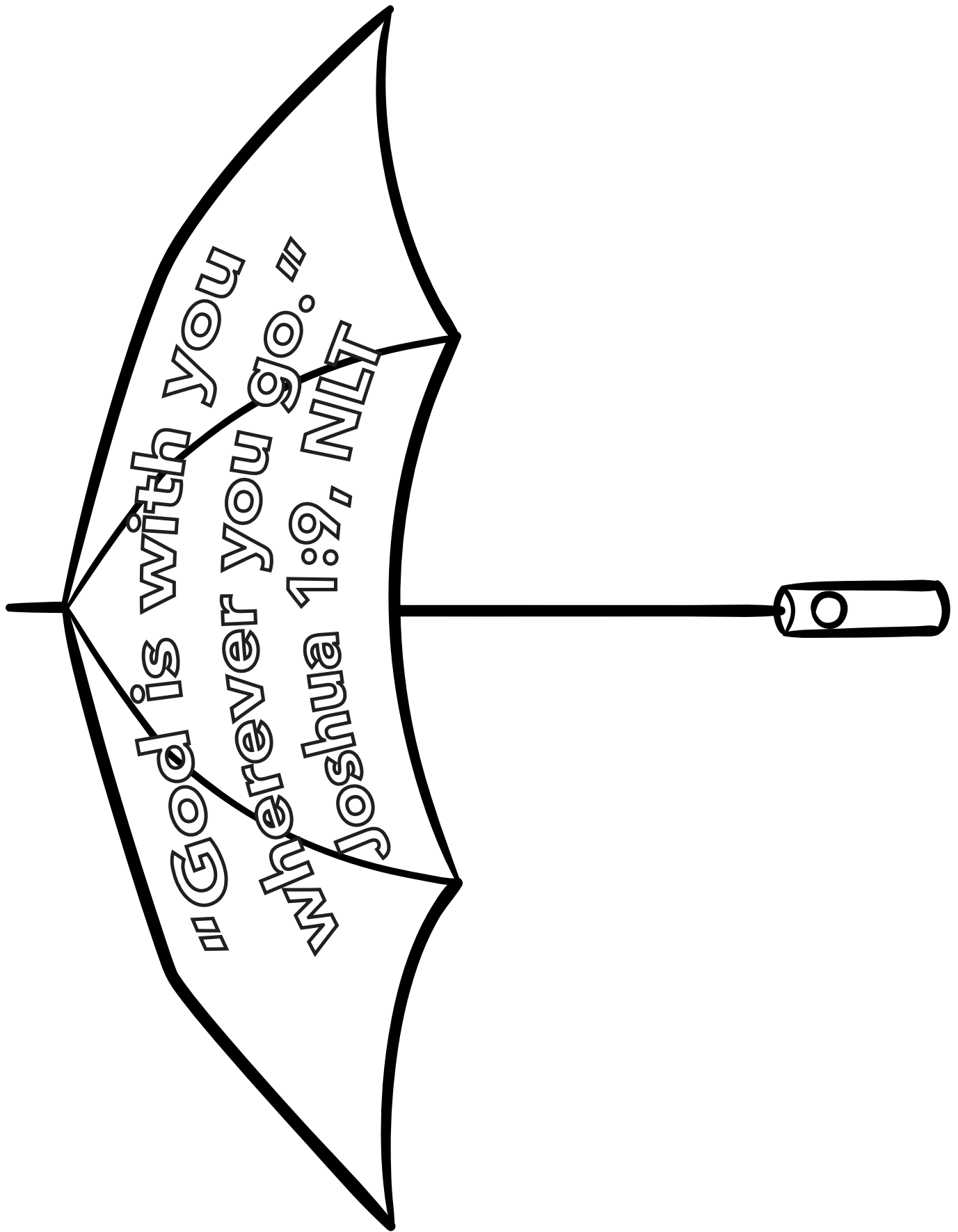
After the Activity: Say the memory verse together.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “When do you use an umbrella? *(Pause.)* Most of the times you use an umbrella when it’s raining. Sometimes you use it when it’s sunny outside. God is with you when it’s sunny or raining, *God is with you wherever you go.*”

During the Activity: “*God is with you wherever you go.* That’s our Memory Verse, and it’s written on the umbrella on your paper. Let’s add some raindrops on your paper – (use either inkpads with fingertips, blue paint, markers or crayons). *(Demonstrate.)* Put as many raindrops on your paper as you want. *(Pause.)* Great job friends!”

After the Activity: “Let’s say our memory verse together. *God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9.* Great! One more time: *God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1:9.* No matter where you go, **[Bottom Line] God’s got it. Who’s got it? [Bottom Line] God’s got it.**”
