### ACTIVITY 1 – INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY

#### MAKE IT FUN

#### INTRODUCTORY ACTIVITY | LIKE

**What You Need:** Phones, plastic megaphones, microphone, walkie talkie etc.

**What You Do:**

*During the Activity:* Encourage the children to select a phone or megaphone. Let the children pretend to call or speak to a friend through their phone/megaphone/microphone or walkie talkie.

**What You Say:**

*During the Activity:* “Everyone select a phone or megaphone. We can tell people things on the phone. Go ahead and start talking! While you are talking say, Jesus wants to be your friend forever!”

*After the Activity:* “That was fun! Everyone, place your phone or megaphone here in the basket. Great job, friends. I heard so many of you talking to your friends. Today, we’ll hear about a very special message that we can share with everyone, everywhere.”

## ACTIVITY 3 – APPLICATION ACTIVITY

### MAKE IT STICK

#### APPLICATION ACTIVITY | COLOR THE WORLD

**What You Need:** “Color the World” Activity Page, cardstock, water color paints, small bowls, paint brushes, water, OR markers, crayons OR glue and tissue paper (blue and green)

#### **What You Do:**

*During the Activity:* Encourage children to paint their world.

*They can use watercolor paints, regular paint, crayons or markers, or glue tissue paper down on the page.*

*After the Activity:* Review the Bible story.

#### **What You Say:**

*Before the Activity:* “Hey, friends! Tell me, who made the earth and everything in it? *(Pause.)* That’s absolutely right! God did! And God gave us His Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever.”

*During the Activity:* “Let’s paint a picture of the earth. Dip your brushes in the water then in the paint. Now paint your world. *(Pause.)* Cover the whole thing. *(Pause.)* You did a really nice job on your painting. Let’s set them aside to dry.”

*After the Activity:* “In our Bible story, Jesus told His friends He had a really important job for them to do. Jesus told them to go tell EVERYONE, EVERYWHERE that Jesus wants to be their friend forever! Jesus wants us to do that same important job! We can tell everyone that Jesus is alive and wants to be their friend forever. **Who wants to be your friend forever? [Bottom Line] Jesus wants to be my friend forever.**”
